

## VIBRAM CELEBRATES THE BOND BETWEEN MILAN AND THE MOUNTAINS

# A SERIES OF EVENTS TO REDISCOVER THE ROOTS OF THE INNOVATION THAT REVOLUTIONIZED MOUNTAINEERING

Milan, September 25, 2025 – Milan holds a rare privilege compared to other major European cities: a constant dialogue with the Alps that rise on the horizon. On clear days, from the spires of the Duomo, the peaks seem to almost touch the city, recalling the deep connection between the metropolis and the mountains.

It was in this landscape, at the beginning of the twentieth century, that Vitale Bramani – from whom the acronym Vibram – discovered his calling. First a mountaineer and mountain guide, then an entrepreneur: in 1928 he opened the first specialized mountain equipment store in Milano, at Via della Spiga 8. A few years later, in 1937, he sparked a revolution destined to mark an era: the first rubber sole for mountain boots, the famous Vibram Carrarmato.

For Vitale Bramani, the mountain was not only a challenge but also a teacher and a refuge, inspiring him to innovate and create design icons that would forever change the world of mountaineering. From the Lombard mountains to the peaks of the Himalayas, his invention has accompanied climbers and explorers for nearly ninety years in reaching the highest and most demanding summits in the world.

Today, Vibram celebrates this bond with "Mountains of Milano," a series of events inviting people to rediscover the deep connections between city and mountain, belonging and inspiration: values that shaped Vitale Bramani's pioneering vision and still guide the company today.

Through stories from mountaineers, installations, conversations, cultural moments, and experiences between Milan and the Alps – from the Central Station to the Lombard mountains – Vibram offers a collective program that explores mountain culture across generations and perspectives.

As part of the "Mountains of Milano" project, a new film dedicated to Vibram's history and directed by Achille Mauri will be premiered: a visual and sound journey to the company's roots, between places of origin and founding values, with the mind in the city and the heart in the mountains.

### **ECHOES OF ALTITUDE**

A multisensory immersion in the heart of Milan.

An immersive installation of sounds and scents, combining Fonetica Glaciale, a sound mapping of the Adamello glacier by sound artist Neunau (Sergio Maggioni), and an olfactive intervention by artist Sissel Tolaas. These elements, along with bites prepared by Altatto, will spark an intimate reflection on the mountain, evoking the sensation of altitude.
